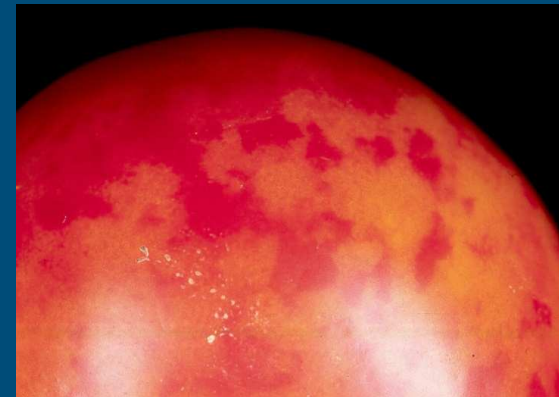
# Form of the meeting
