Social relations – Witte Vlieg

Gardening together is more fun:

"I am 44 years old, the soccer club is not feasible. (...) I enjoy to do something that we have in common, with different people that are usually involved in different things."

- Different people, shared interest
- Remains limited to the garden



Social relations - Bioakker

- Shared interest in organic, alternative ways of living
- Different groups of people incrowd/ outcrowd




Social contacts
