Aim

Improvement of quality management and food safety and therefore a positive impact on the competitiveness of the vegetable supply chain in Indonesia.

Activities

- Research to risks on unsafe food in the vegetable supply chain, conform a HACCP approach
- Development and testing of Good Agricultural Practices
- Training on quality assurance and food safety control measures
- Tests and participatory workshops with growers and other stakeholders in the vegetable supply chain

Tujuan

- Pelatihan menyangkut asuransi/jaminan kualitas serta cara-cara pengendalian keamanan pangan
- Pengujian dan lokakarya partisipatif dengan produsen/petani serta partisipan/stakeholders lain dalam rantai pasokan sayuran
