German Adaptation Strategy (DAS)




adopted by federal cabinet in 2008

Requirements for Indicators

- cover the 15 action fields of DAS
 → close reference to its objectives and contents
- highlight the cause-effectrelationships of climate impacts
- existing data → immediately implementable

Methodology

- Systematic analysis of DAS and literature review
- Identification and priorisation of key impacts and responses
- Participation and transparency on a high level
 - Consultations (160 institutions, 250 persons)
 - Expert working groups: representatives from authorities from different levels, scientists and stakeholders
 - bilateral work with experts on specific questions (define indicators and specify data base)
 - Review of indicator- and data factsheets by experts
- Existing data from monitoring programmes


Technical level


- · Currently more than 110 suggestions
- Current aim: to have 2-3 impact indicators and 2-3 response indicators per field of action (in sum: 60 – 90 indicators)


Political level


 We started a process of political commitment (August 2012 – April 2013) to create a stable system based on valid data and a broad backing
