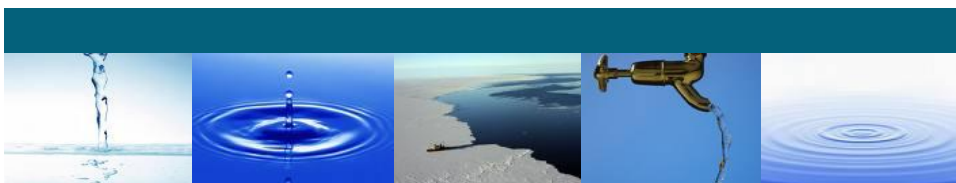


4. (a) Planning, prioritizing and implementing adaptation actions, including specific projects and programmes.....

**4 (e) Building resilience of socio-economic and ecological systems**, including through economic diversification and **sustainable management of natural resources**

**10. Option 1:** Such centres will be designated, guided and controlled by the countries they are to serve and shall facilitate and enhance action on adaptation, **building upon and complementing national adaptation action, especially between countries with shared natural resources, where appropriate.**
