## National Implementing <br> Entities accredited to the Fund


adaptation fund
Accreditation of small entities - AF streamlined process


- Small governments (e.g. in SIDS and LDCs) may not have suitable NIE candidates that are able to access up to USD 10 million
- AFB mandated Accreditation Panel to contemplate "fit for purpose" criteria for small entities accreditation
- AFB approved a modified accreditation process for small entities in April 2015
- 1 small island NIE accredited
