- Learning to work in a cross-over environment and a transdisciplinary team requires a new way of learning, thinking and developing. Not just for students, but also for teachers and others
















Challenges for education institutes

 - O Education institutions must welcome changes to the way they are organized. From strategic, structural and operational levels to leadership, systems and staff.






What does it mean for you?
