

- Strategic cost comparison (labour, interest, feed)




Cost of production on farm (€/kg)














Production cost of supply chain

- Two products: Shoulder meat and Tenderloin
- From 8 countries to the German market
- Costs:
 - Slaughter and processing costs
 - Transport
 - Import levies
- Professional estimate based on Dutch situation
 - Specified per country
- Cost =/= market price




Cost of supply chain to German market

Pig sector Poland

- Small-scaled and fragmented
- Low performance
- Low willingness to cooperate
- Credit facilities are uncommon
- Large-scale integrations discover societal resistance
- And the future?



Critical factors for new Member states

- Credit facilities
- Farm comparison
- Infrastructure
- Communication (within supply chain and with society)



Critical factors new Member states

- Disease eradication plan
- Use of genetic hybrids
- Professional organisation of the supply chain
- Don't forget: The glass is half-full, not half-empty
