










## PFA fisheries: efficient food production at sea

EM + observer + discard samples


























This one if for discard composition

### Conclusions on Electronic Monitoring

- Factory cameras work well
- Rear deck cameras sometimes difficult to interpret
- Learning what it means: switching-off cameras during 'events'
- Can underwater 'events' be seen? (slipping)
