#### Climate Change: clear and present danger


US Coast houses 39% of all Americans and 45% of the US GDP. 50% is vulnerable to sea level rise

Drought is potentially an even greater threat to the USA


Snow and ice (or a lack of it)

Inventory of effects are available: Pay now or pay later?






