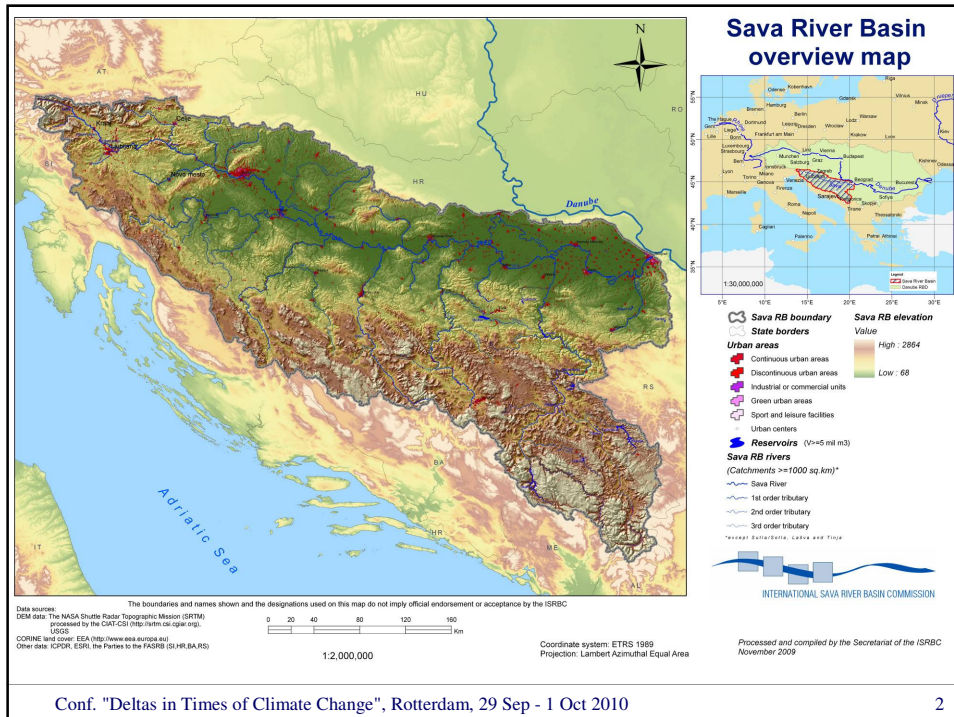

Challenges

- **1990's to 2000's:**
 - **In Europe:** IWRM strongly promoted
 - **In the Sava basin:** IWRM did not exist
- **Since 2000's:**
 - **Framework Agreement on the Sava River Basin**
 - **International Sava River Basin Commission**
 - **4 Parties**
(Bosnia & Herzegovina, Croatia, Serbia, Slovenia)

Ambitions

- **Integration** in WRM
 - Integration **over the basin**
 - **Cross-sectoral** integration
 - **Protection** issues
 - **Development** activities
- **Commitment** to respecting the EU regulation and the UNECE Water Convention

Activities


- **RBM Plan** (EU WFD)
- **Flood Risk Management Plan** (EU Flood Dir.)
- **GIS** (EU WFD, INSPIRE, WISE)
- **Hydro-Meteorological Information System**
- **Flood Forecasting and Warning System**
- **Water and Climate Adaptation Plan**
- **UNECE Pilot Project**
