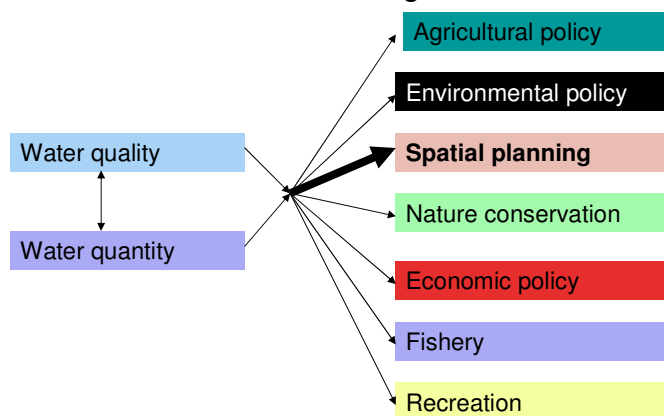
Three points of attention

1.Integrality

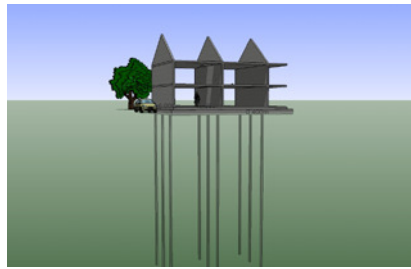
- Reality is undivided

Internal and external integration

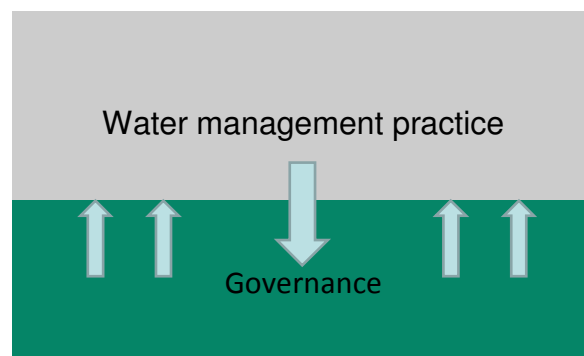


2. Good governance

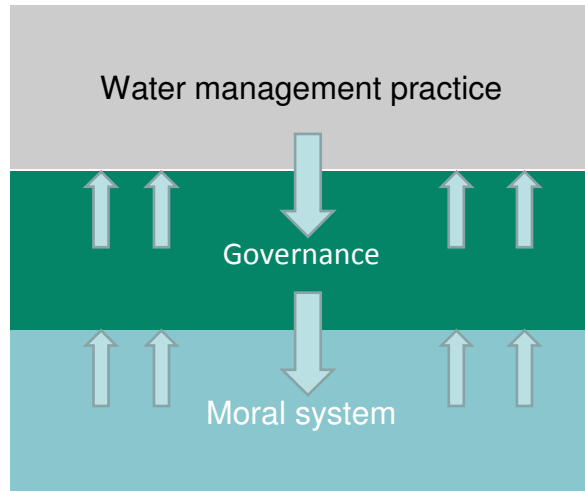
A building must have a foundation
The foundation must rest on solid soil



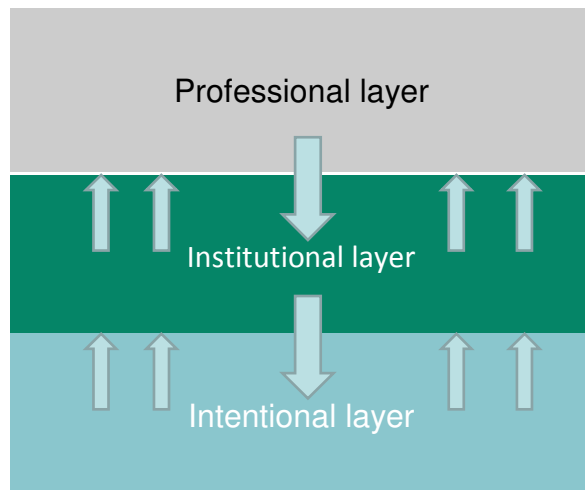
Two layers: building and foundation
