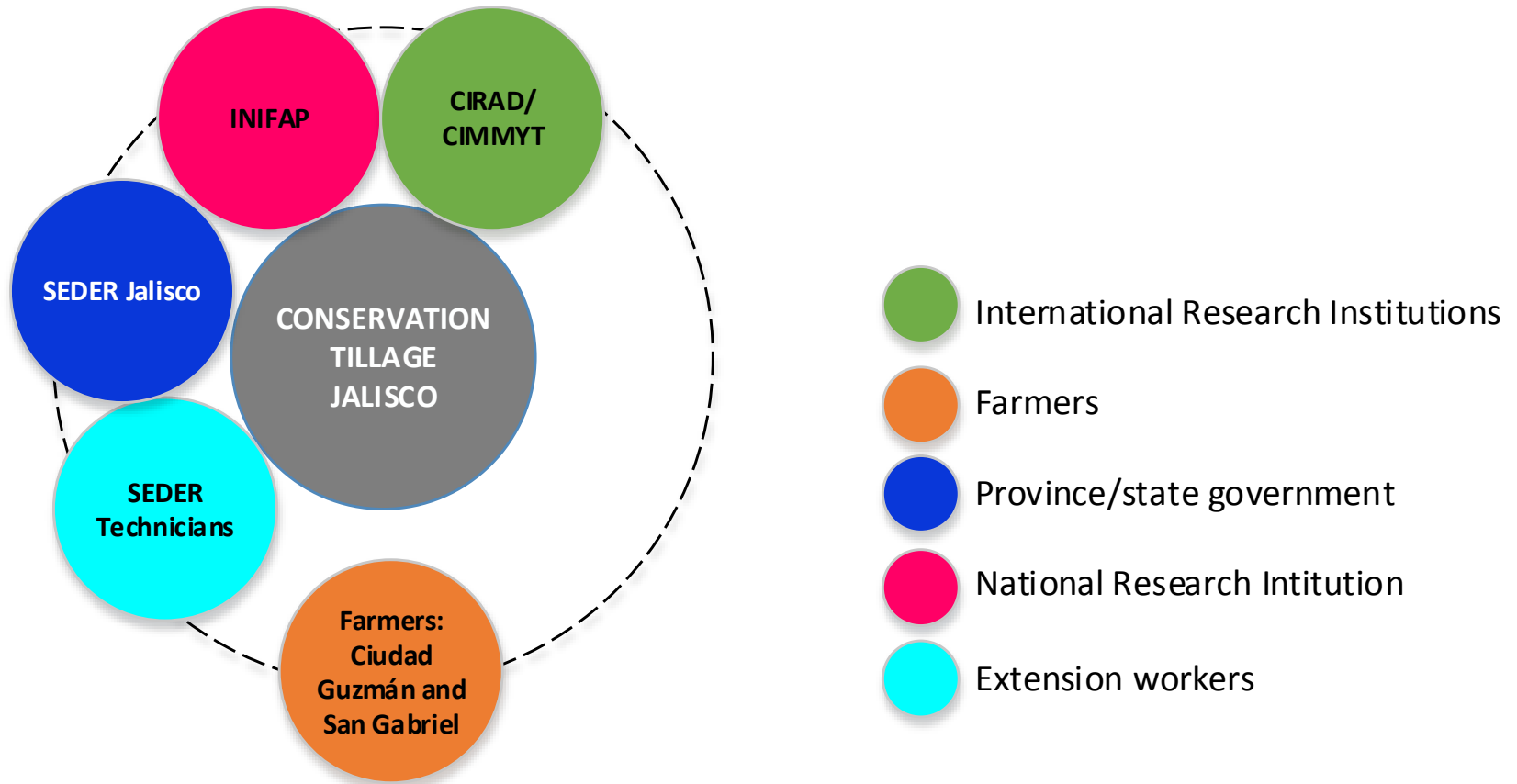

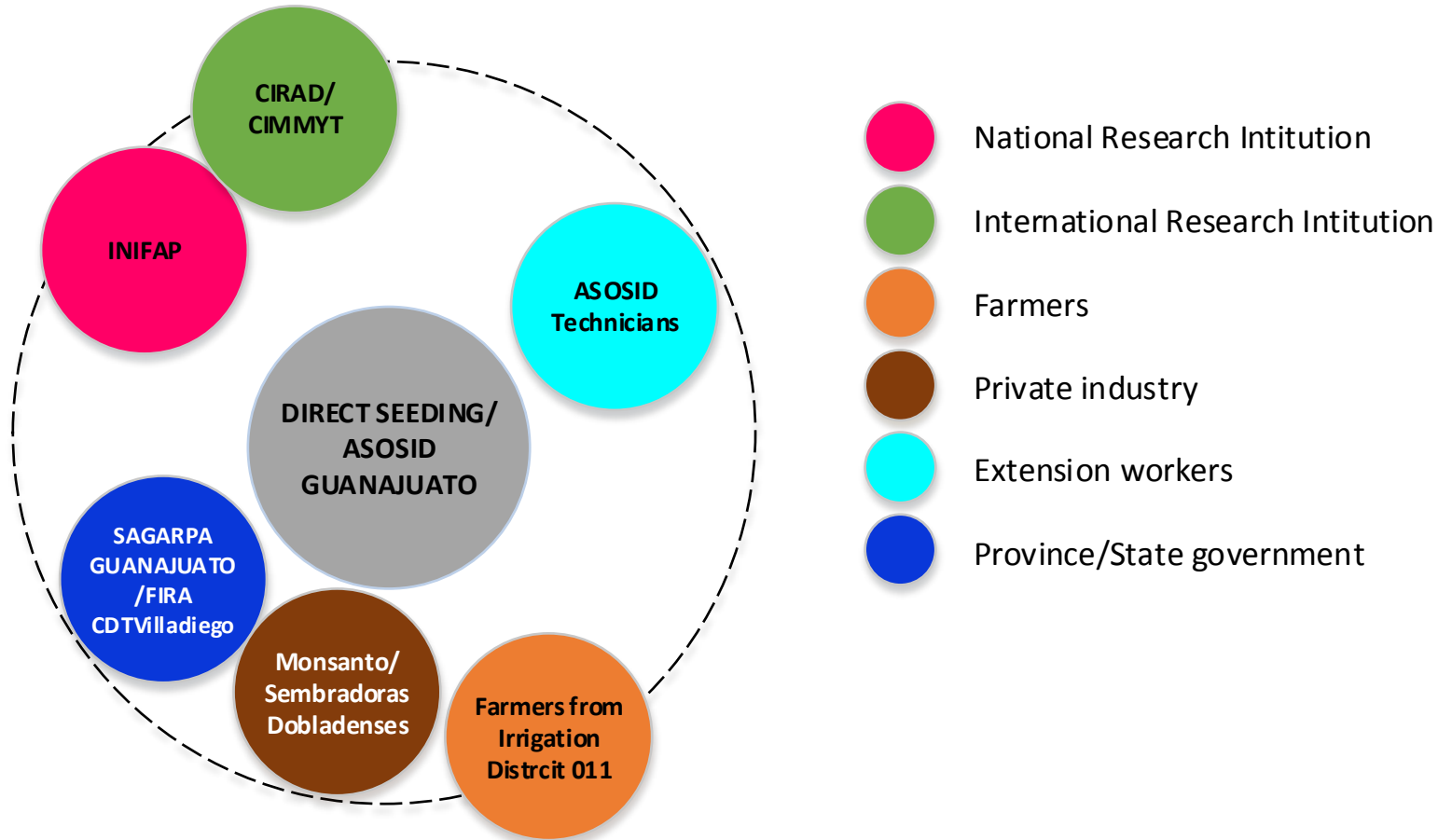

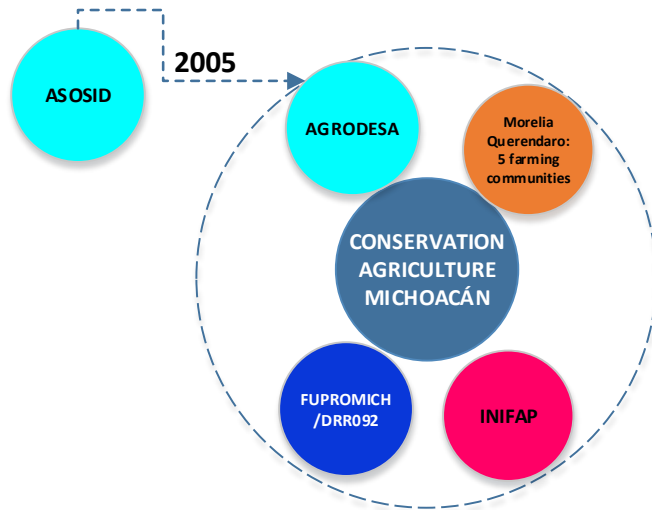

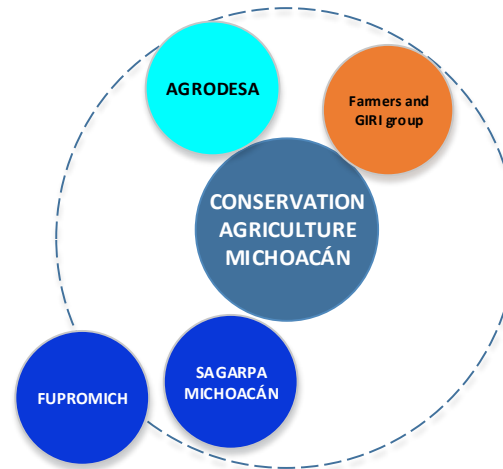

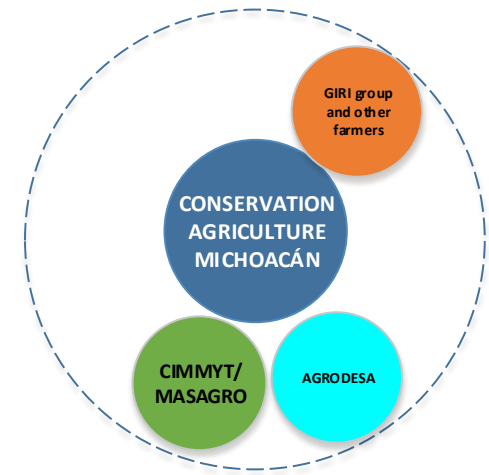
4.a.: Configuration of the boundary object in 2006

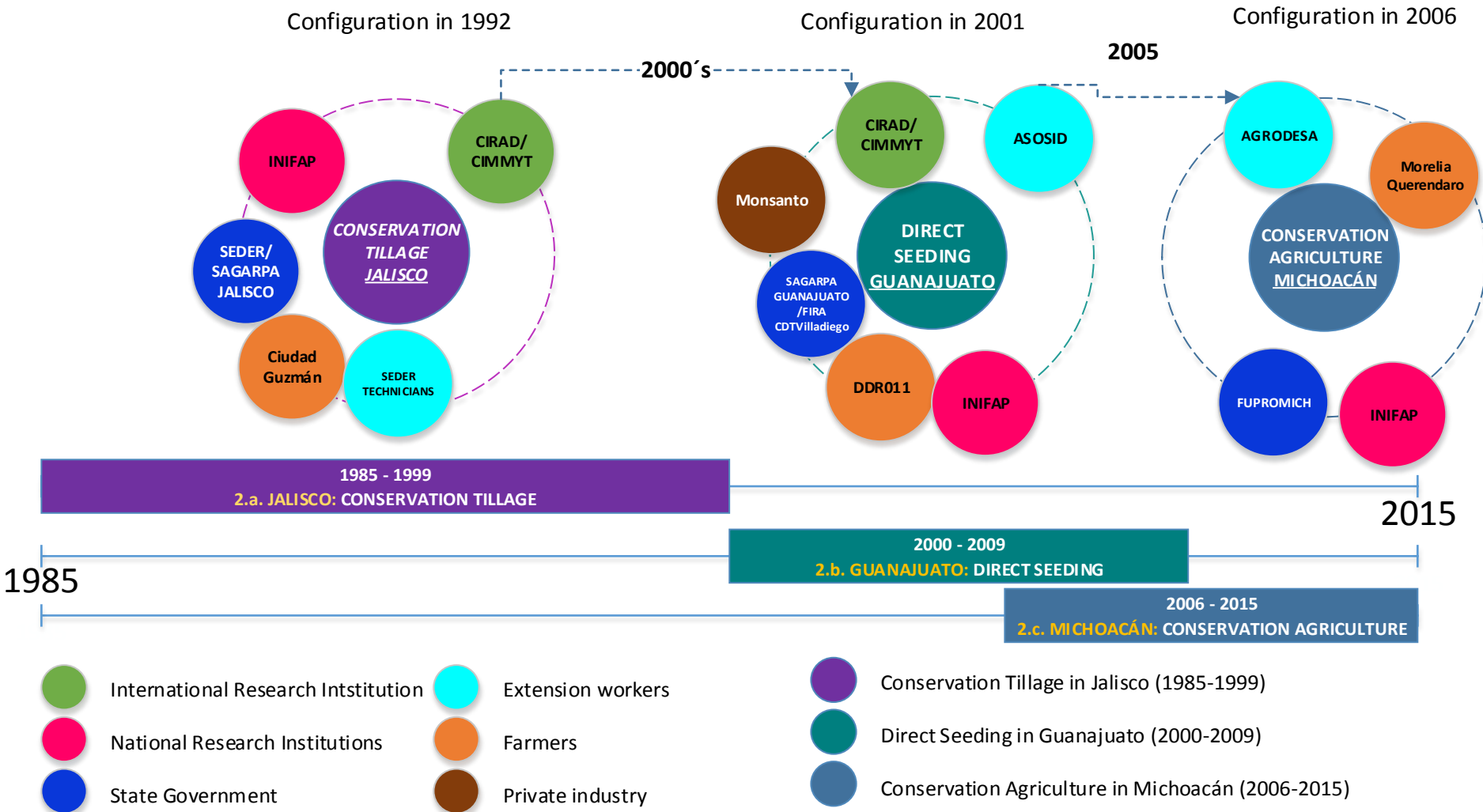
