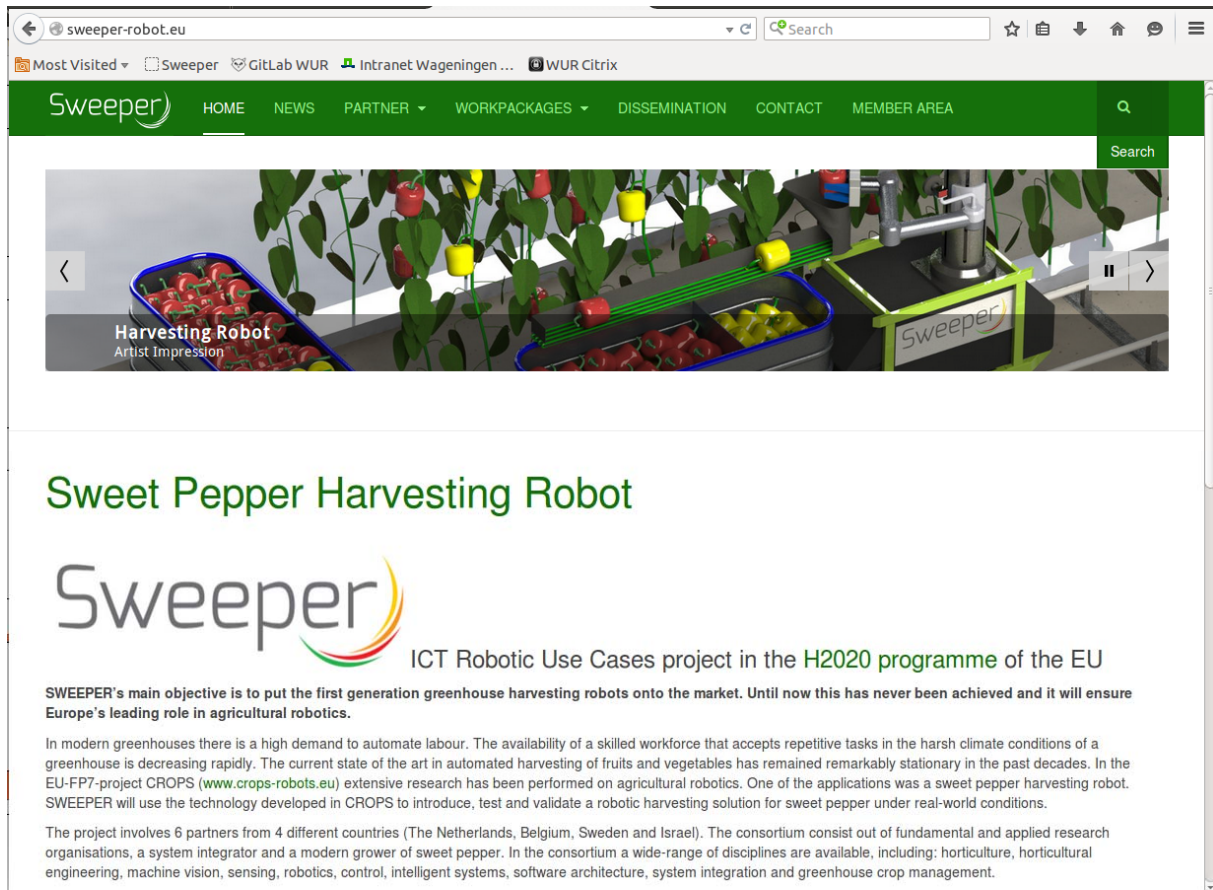


Figure 1: Screenshot of the homepage of Sweeper

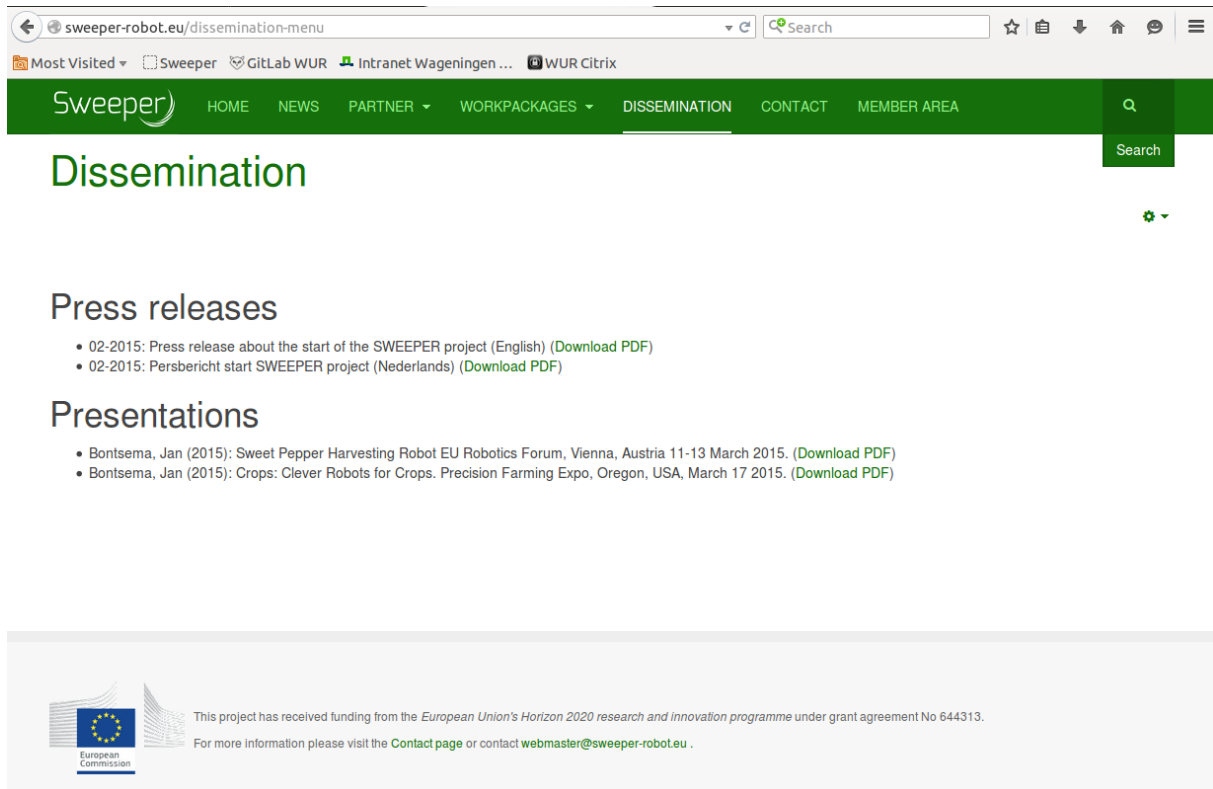


Figure 2: Screenshot of the dissemination website accessed on 20-05-2015
