This calls for wider reaching impact than individual supply chains.

Reaching beyond the value chain

A high performing agri-food sector requires an organised base of professional producers, markets that reward not only quality but sustainability, and viable service delivery models. Whilst in recent years we have witnessed the success of the 'value chain' approach, bringing best practices to scale is not possible without sector-wide coordination. Too often is the importance of having strong institutions in governance overlooked, a blind spot for transforming islands of success into seas of change.
