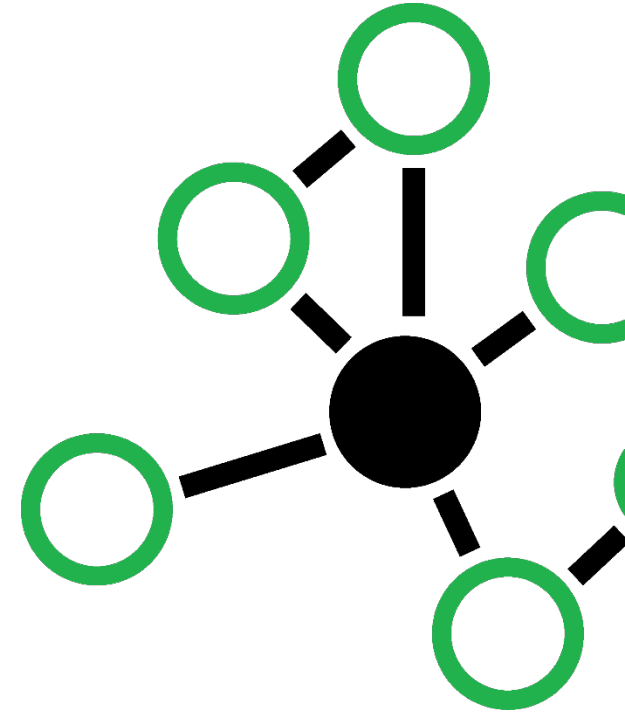

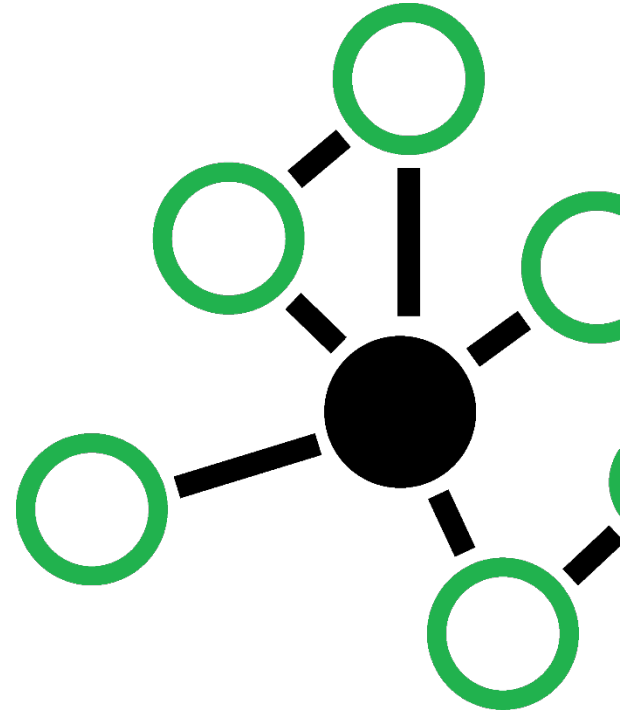

# What is (a) Data Steward(ship)

- Operates within a research group
- Provides advice/support to researchers on RDM in the whole data cycle
- Translates WUR data policy to practical solutions within the research groups
- Connection between DMS & Researcher



# Potential tasks

- 'Technical'
  - Database management (Quality, integrity...)
  - Data analyses advise
  - Data tools and applications
- 'Researcher support in the domain'
  - Knowledge transfer on existing data collections. Data licenses, ownership etc.
  - Knowledge transfer on domain standards
  - Connection between DMS & Researcher
- 'Motivation and awareness'
  - Initiates and stimulates new RDM policies & practices within the research groups
  - Motivation and support of researchers in doing RDM
