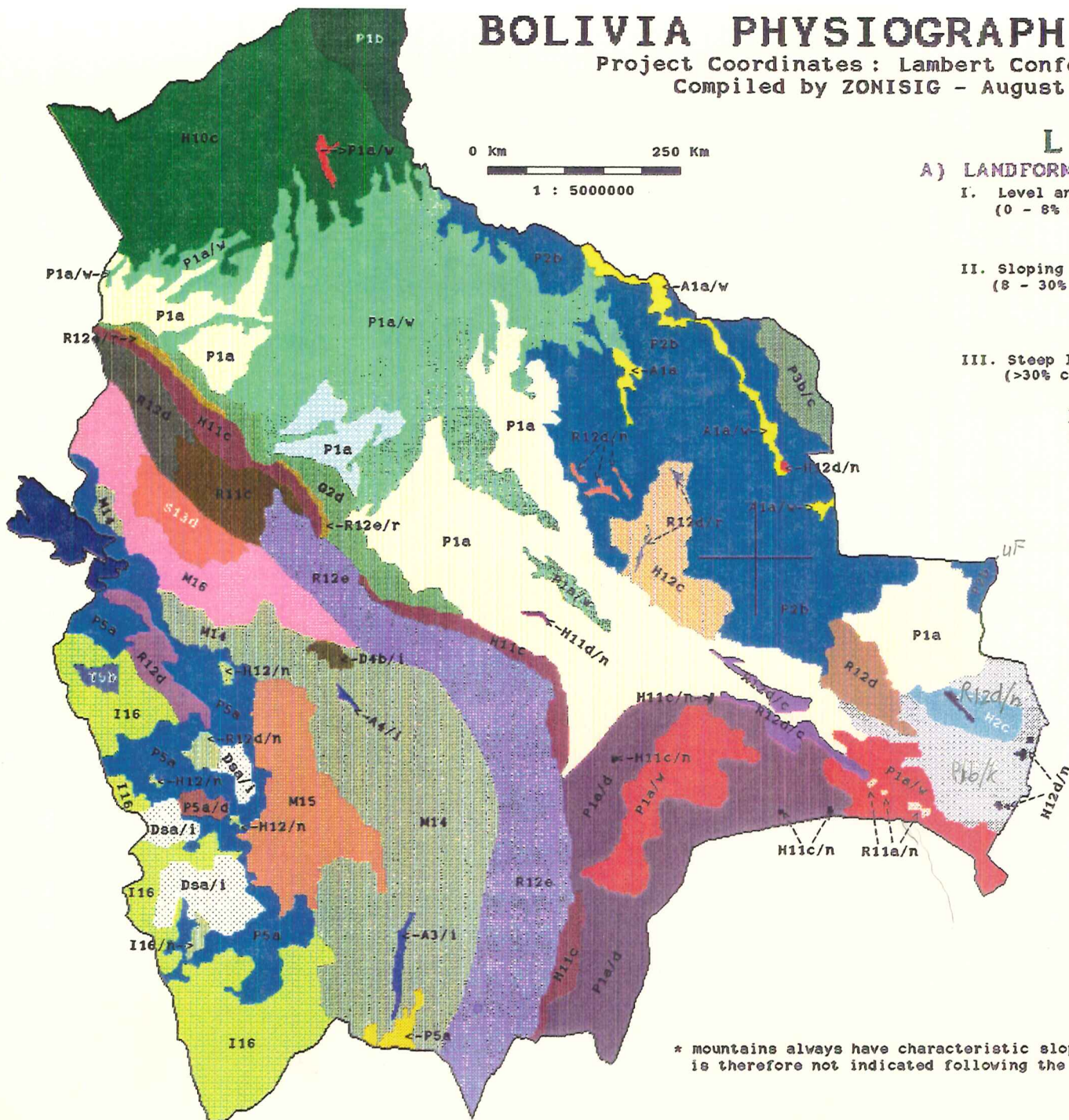


# BOLIVIA PHYSIOGRAPHIC FAO MAP
