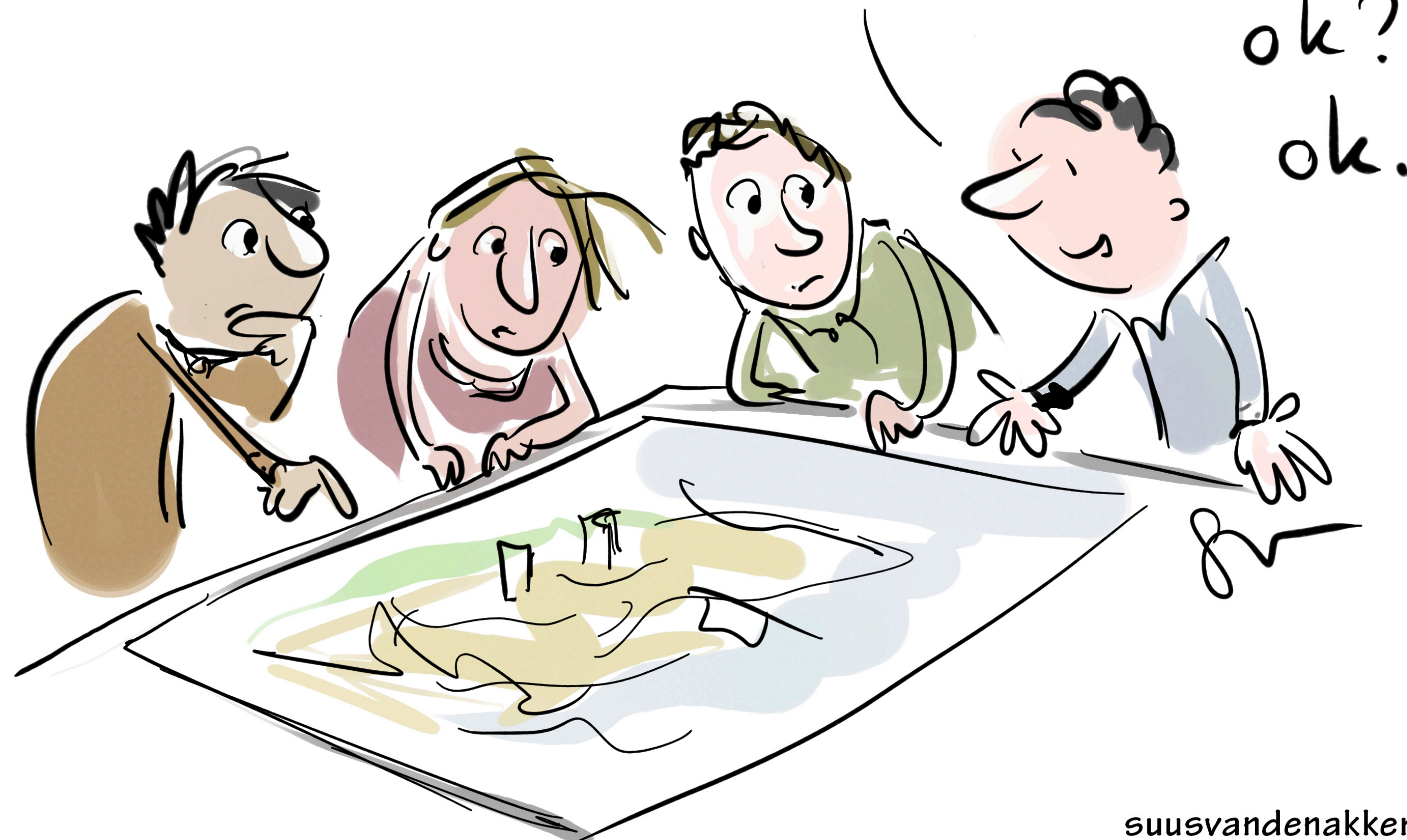

- Increased democracy and citizen participation

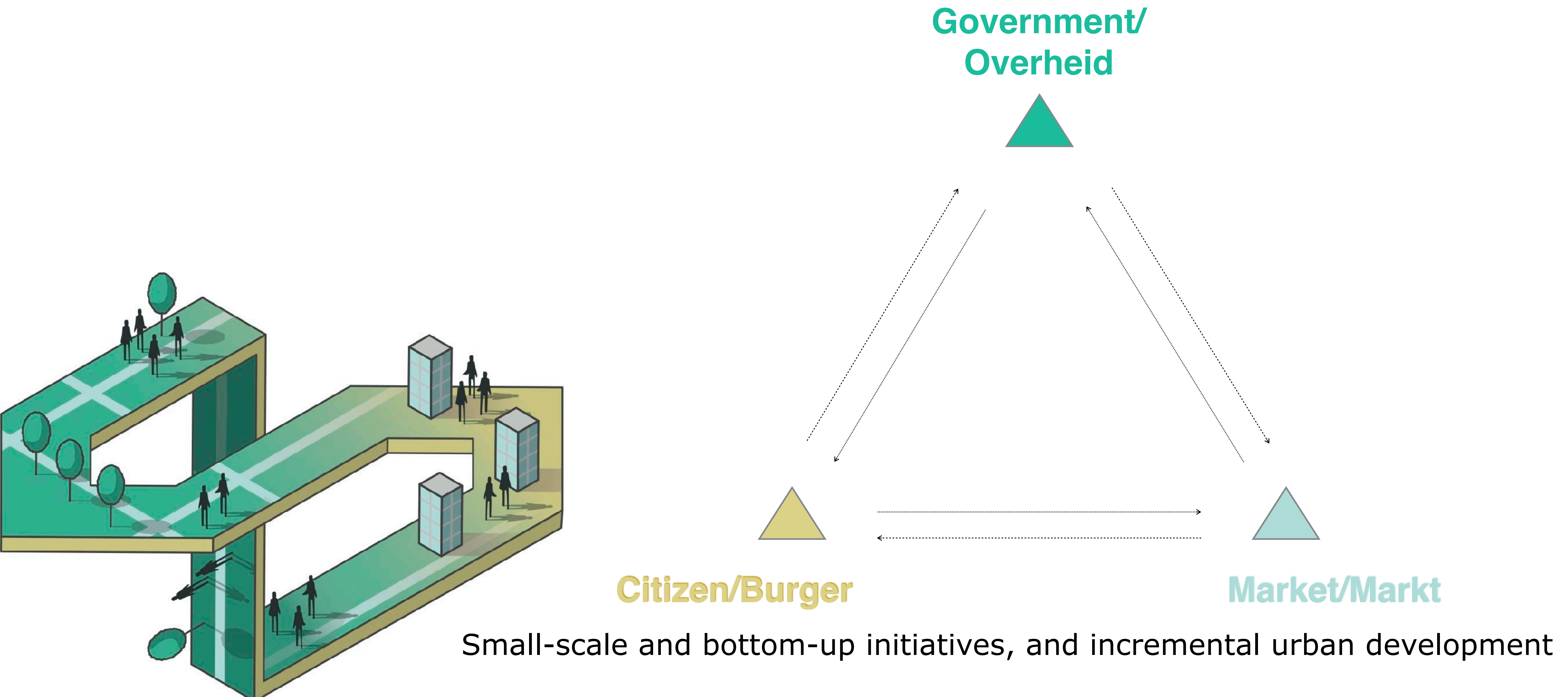

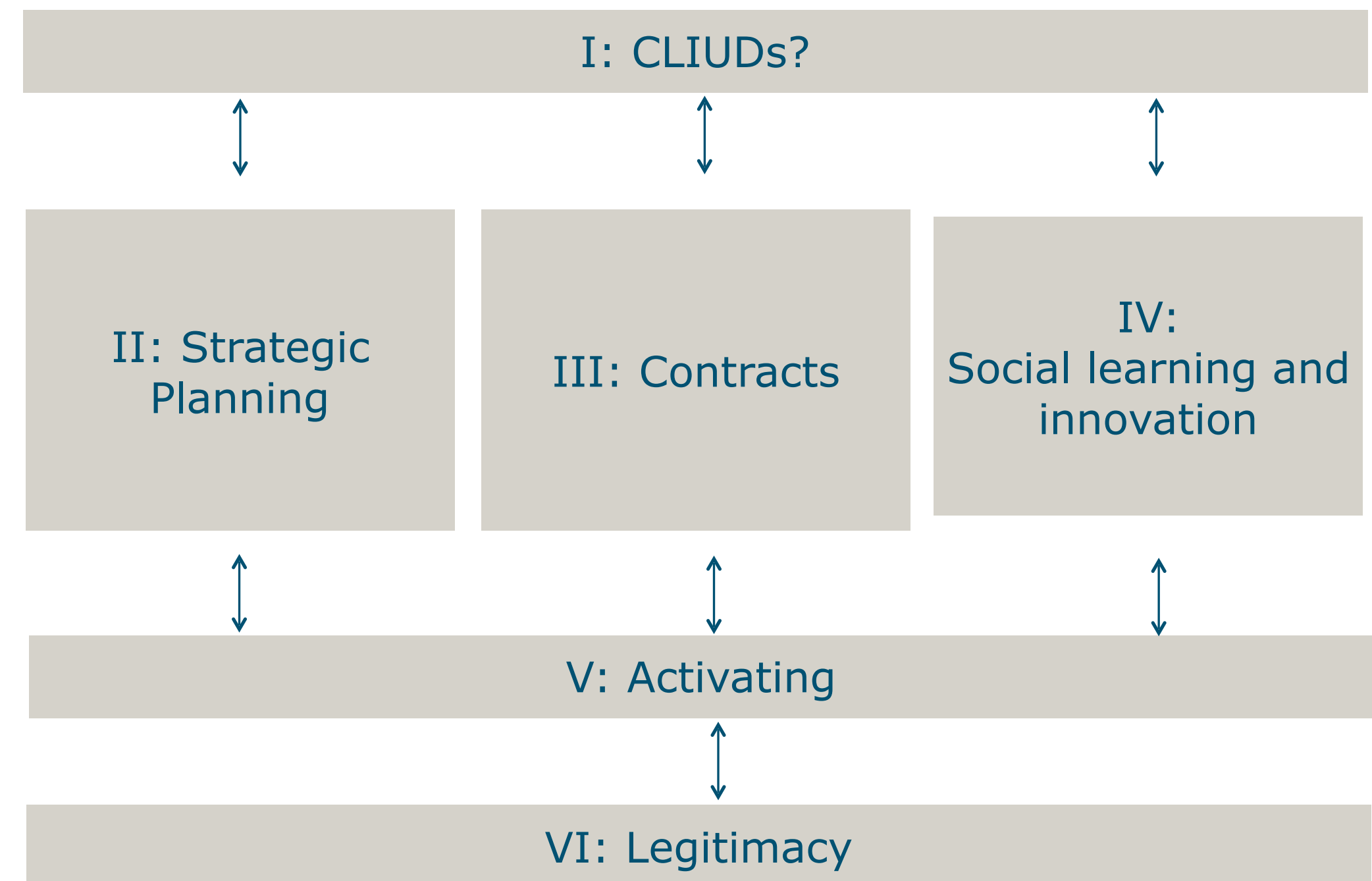

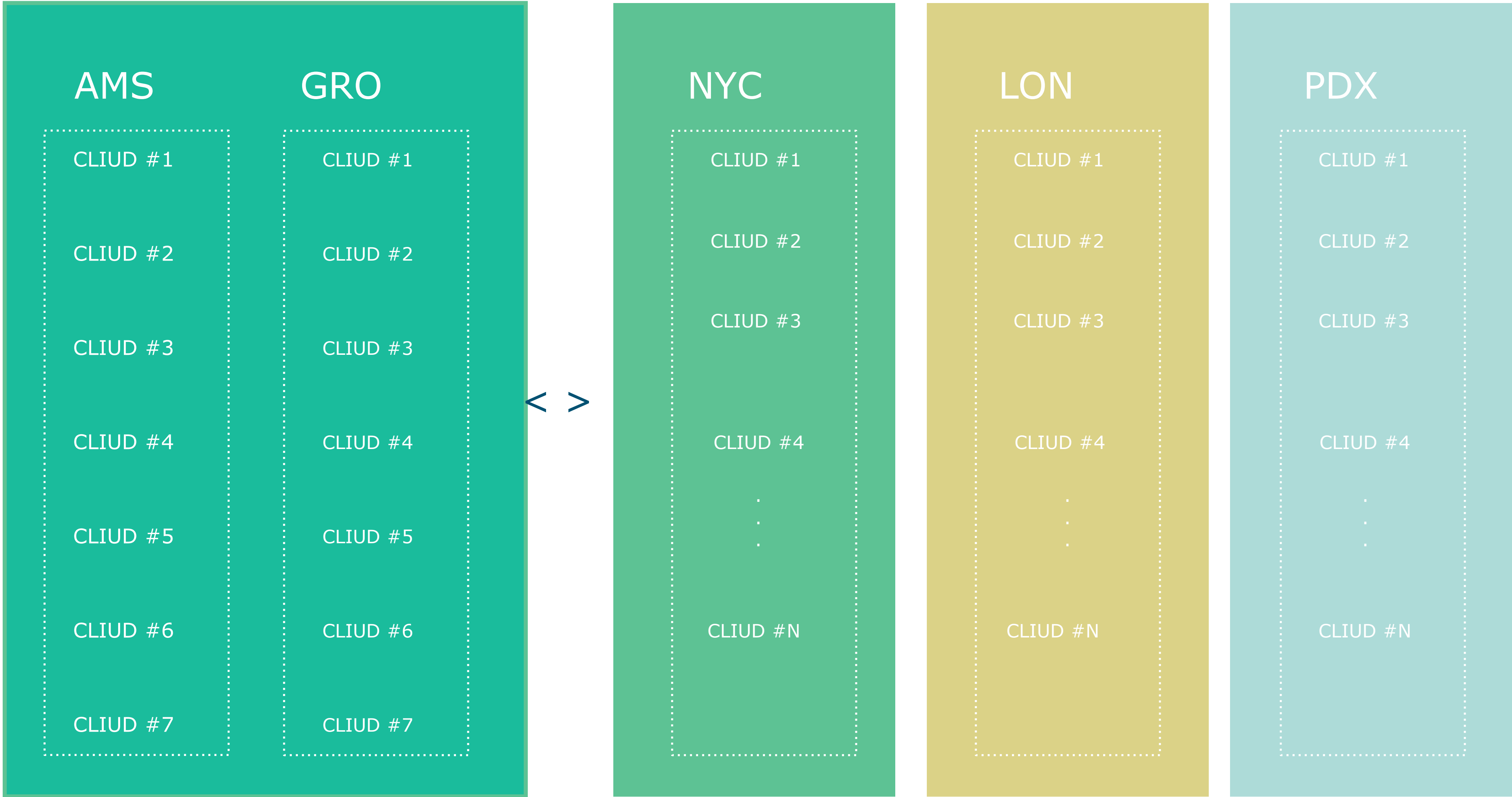
