





# How to log in git.wur.nl with two-factor authentication

## Step 1. Login

In your browser enter the url [git.wur.nl](https://git.wur.nl). You will be redirected to the login page.

<p><b>WUR employees and students</b></p> <p>Press the Sign in with <b>WUR email address</b> button.</p> 	<p><b>External Users</b></p> <p>Enter your email address and password and sign in.</p>

## Step 2. Two-factor authentication

<p><b>WUR employees and students</b></p> <p>Now you can use the standard way to sign in to WUR applications, enter you email address and press 'Next'</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Microsoft authenticator app will pop up on your telephone.</li><li>• Click yes to accept the log on.</li><li>• You will be redirected to the default webpage.</li></ul>	<p><b>External users</b></p> <p>A second form called Two-Factor Authentication will appear. You have to enter the code from a two-factor authentication app on your mobile device like Microsoft Authenticator or Google Authenticator</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Open a two-factor authentication app like Microsoft Authenticator or Google Authenticator.</li><li>• Select the git.wur.nl account.</li><li>• The one-time code will be presented for a limited time</li><li>• Enter this as 'Two-factor authentication code' in the form</li><li>• Press the button 'Verify code'</li></ul> <p>You will be redirected to the default webpage</p>
